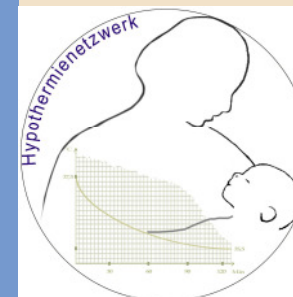

The “Symposium on DR-management” traditionally provides a **platform for scientific exchange** for European clinicians and researchers with a special interest in that field.

The “Symposium on Hypothermia” was initiated as a platform for the German Hypothermienetzwerk. In 2013 we are also inviting European participants to join the symposium since all presentations will now be available both in **English and German** (simultaneous translation).

The scientific program of the meeting in Dresden was developed by the scientific advisory board, consisting of active members of the **European Scientific Collaboration of Neonatal Resuscitation (ESCNR)** and the **German Hypothermienetzwerk**.


